

City of McGregor Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Budget Cover Page

This budget will raise more revenue from property taxes than last year's budget by an amount of \$69,260, which is a 2.53 percent increase from last year's budget. The property tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year is \$45,743.
