

## How your City Utility Bill is calculated:

The Utility Maintenance Department drives through the neighborhood and radio reads your meter in thousands. The meters are read around the middle of the month, depending on the demands made on the utility department.

### **Example:**

Meter dials show 325520 (this includes the pre-stamped 0)

The current/present read is recorded as **325** because reads are recorded in thousands.

The previous reported read was **312**

The difference between the reads is 13 which equates to 13,000 gallons.

### **Water portion of bill:**

Demand Fee

\$35.00 based on a 3/4" meter

Water Usage

\$79.10 **13000** gallons

**\$114.10** First 5000 gallons billed at \$3.98 per thousand = \$19.90  
Next 8000 gallons billed at \$7.40 per thousand= \$59.20

### **WasteWater portion of bill:**

Demand fee

\$38.69

Winter Averaged

\$14.17 Average gallons used in the recent winter months was 3667

**\$52.86** Billed at \$3.86 per 1000 gallons

The winter average will remain the same until after the next winter averaging is calculated for the account.

Residential Roll-out Cart
